Pecha Kucha is Japanese for the sound of conversation. It taps into a demand for a forum in which creative work can be easily and informally shown. It has spread to over 80 cities across the world and now it's here, in Montpelier!

Pecha Kucha Night, devised by architects Astrid Klein and Mark Dytham, was conceived in 2003 as a place for young designers to meet, network, and show their work in public in Tokyo.

The key to **Pecha Kucha** Night is that each **presenter** is allowed **20 images**, each shown for **20 seconds** each - giving **6 minutes 40 seconds of fame** before the next presenter is up. This keeps presentations concise, the interest level up, and gives more people the chance to show.

Beginning in May, ORE will host regular Pecha Kucha nights to uncover and celebrate ideas and talent in Vermont.
